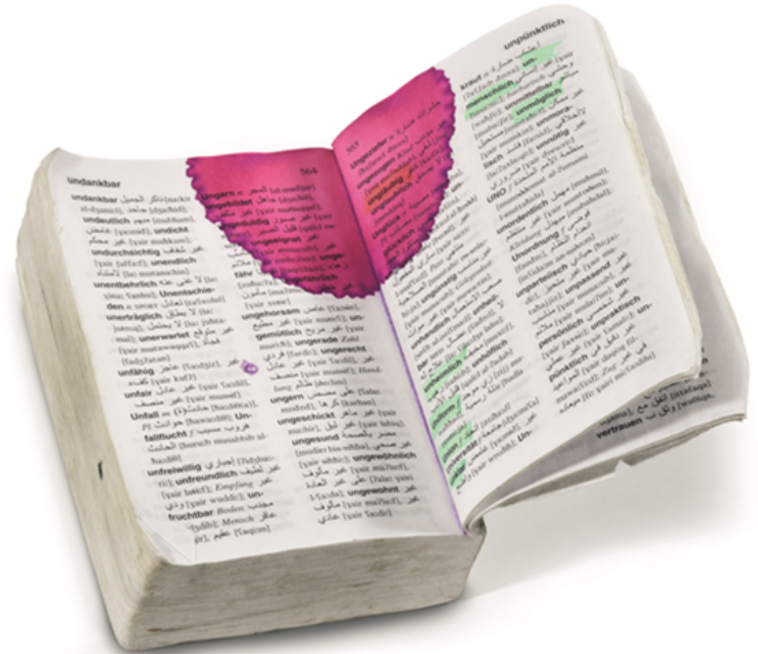


Every story is told in three languages: german and english (text) and the mother tongue of the protagonists (audio file).
